Biography

Jacob is currently Organ Scholar at Salisbury Cathedral having previously spent a year as Organ Scholar at Hereford Cathedral. Before that, Jacob studied at St John's School, Leatherhead and the Junior Department of the Royal Academy of Music. During this time, he studied organ with Anne Marsden Thomas MBE and Dr Frederick Stocken, continuo playing with Debbie Diamond, and conducting with Dominic Grier. In autumn 2025, he will matriculate as Organ Scholar at Clare College, Cambridge, where he will read for a degree in Divinity. He became a prizewinning Associate of the Royal College of Organists in 2022.
